

Minutes of IQAC Meeting of UG and PG final semester, Date: 25th May 2019

The Chairperson, Sw. Shastrajnananda welcomed all members present.

Each of the departments in both the UG and PG were requested to take up in detail the results of students. The process was initiated by the Controller of Examinations, who briefed the house regarding the overall performance of the students in the Semester exams in each department:

1) Department of Sanskrit:

- a. For PG Sanskrit, result of Biswajit Das was not satisfactory.
- b. For PG Sanskrit, the progress of student Hembram is not satisfactory. The HOD mentioned it may be due to his performance in grammar and composition.
- c. Out of 11 final year students, 9 have already qualified NET/SET.

2) Department of Political Science:

- a. The HOD mentioned that the present outgoing batch is academically balanced.
- b. Performance of the students in other national level entrance examinations like JNU, BHU was also satisfactory.
- c. Darpan Bhattacharya and Sourav Chakraborty both are good students.

3) Department of Physics:

- a. Performance of Krishnendu Majhi is good. He is supposed to get admission in IIT Bombay.
- b. It was discussed why progress was satisfactory.
- c. More interactions with students are necessary to guide them.
- d. It is suggested by Respected Principal Maharaj to take up online examination system as the facility is available with the college.

4) Department of Philosophy:

- a. For UG all except Mithun Pal, all secured 1st class.
- b. Overall progression of the PG batch is satisfactory.
- c. All PG students of the current batch have qualified NET/SET.
- d. It was specially mentioned by Respected Principal Maharaj that Subrata Tudu, who was a sweeper, has qualified NET this year from the department.

5) Department of Microbiology:

- a. It is mentioned by the HOD that performance of Jyoti Barman is satisfactory.
- b. The overall progression of the entire batch is satisfactory.
- c. Two students have qualified JAM from this batch. They are supposed to join IIT.

6) Department of Mathematics:

- a. In UG batch, all except Santanu Majhi secured first class.
- b. PG result is overall satisfactory.
- c. Monodeep Raha of 3rd year has secured rank in TIFR. All students secured good ranks in IIT/ISI/RKMVERI entrances.

7) Department of Applied Chemistry and Industrial Chemistry:

- a. For PG batch 14 out of 17 students have qualified GATE.

- b. In UG batch Sushovon Dey could not secure 1st class. Some students of this batch may join Sardar Patel Institute.
- c. Two students from UG and PG each have joined Emami through campus recruitment.
- d. Overall progression of both the batches is more or less satisfactory.

8) Department of History:

- a. All the students have secured 1st class.
- b. Overall progression of the students is satisfactory.
- c. Some students are appearing for CLAT, BHU. Manjul and Biplob will appear for BHU.

9) Department of English:

- a. The overall performance of the current batch is satisfactory.
- b. Sayantan is going to join EFLU, Hyderabad.
- c. Niladri will be appearing for JNU.

10) Department of Computer Science:

- a. Except Aarko Dutta, all secured 1st class.
- b. Students are appearing for NIT, BHU, Pune and RKMVERI for PG courses.
- c. Shubham Dhar was selected by TCS in off campus recruitment drive.
- d. Performance of Anal Bera and Sourav Chabri was satisfactory.
- e. Sayan Das will opt of government job right after graduation.

11) Department of Chemistry:

- a. Overall performance of the students was satisfactory.
- b. Eleven students qualified for JAM for the current batch.
- c. The HOD said that due to changed question pattern in JAM, the result in JAM is not satisfactory.

12) Department of Bengali:

- a. Performances of both UG and PG are satisfactory. All secured 1st class.
- b. Two of the PG batch has qualified SET.
- c. Most of the students are going for B.Ed course.

13) Department of Economics:

- a. 7 students secured first class out of 9.
- b. Jyoti Rath's performance is good.
- c. Rajat's performance was not satisfactory.
- d. Mridutpal qualified for IIPS, IGIBR.

Miscellaneous: The house expressed satisfaction at the feedback obtained from especially students and the subsequent follow up by the departments in improving the quality in the teaching-learning exercise on a sustained and regular basis.
