 - i. Comprehension and Vocabulary: [MCQ (Multiple Choice Questions) type]:

20 marks (10 questions of 2 marks each. For each wrong answer, -1 will be awarded)

ii. Essay: 20 marks (one out of five topics on issues of general interest)

[Note: Essays of only those candidates who secure 10 or more marks in the MCQ round will be evaluated.]



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
