Fifth meeting of the Board of Studies



Minutes of BoS
Department of History

Date: 18.03.16

- The proceedings of the last meeting held on 26.02.2014 were read out by Prof. Prithwiraj Biswas and accepted by the members present.
- Prof. Prithwiraj Biswas read out the results of last two years and spelled out the activities of the department during the same time.
- It was decided to introduce 10 multiple choice questions (MCQ) carrying 1 mark for each course. Overall marks division of each group would be as follows:
 - 10 MCQ carrying 1 mark=10
 - 4 short notes out of seven choices carrying 5 marks=20
 - 1 essay type question out of 3 choices carrying 20 marks=20
- It was decided that ^{sixth} ~~fifth~~ semester students would be completing a project comprising of 50 marks as part of their overall UG Honours course. The division of marks would be as follows:
 - 30 Marks for project
 - 10 Marks for Presentation
 - 10 Marks for Viva-voce
- Prof. Prithwiraj Biswas, Prof. Santanu Dey and Prof. Gautam Mukhopadhyay proposed the following changes in the syllabus which were discussed in details by the members of BoS. Resolved that the following revisions be done and be introduced from July 2016:
