The RUSA state project Directorate has instructed that the work under RUSA funding is to be completed within 31 March 2015. When we were preparing the budget, we were of a notion that we might get longer time of a year. In fact, we are getting note more than 7/8 months to complete the project.

Secondly, we have completed the expenditure under 1st installment and is about to submit the UC etc. But, we assume, the second installment will, perhaps reach us by end of 4th week of October. Now, Puja Vacation has started. Although, we will continue our work, it may not be possible for us to keep the same pace.

In our budget, we kept a component 'Increasing the strength of students creating new residential rooms on the 3rd floor of Vinay Bhavan (hostel) (Rs 49.76 lakhs)' under 'RENOVATION/UP-GRADATION OF EXISTING FACILITIES ITEMS (35% OF TOTAL FUND i.e. RS 0.7 CRORE)'. Ours is a residential complex, tightly accommodated. We need vacation period for any major renovation or upgradation in hostel buildings. During Puja, we will almost get no time to work there. We earlier planned to work during summer when we get almost one and half month.

For us, it is also not possible always, what we have done in case of 1st installment, to continue such work out of the college funding till the Government funding does not come.

❖ Resolution for appealing to the Higher Education Department for sanctioning Ad-hoc Accumulated Deficit Grant

The Governing Body noted with concern that the net deficit during the financial year 2014-15 (year ended 31 March 2015) was **Rs. 33,55,053.04 (Rupees thirty three lakhs fifty five thousand fifty three and paise zero four only**) as per the Balance Sheet for the financial year 2014-15 drawn up and finalized by the auditors appointed by the State Government. The principal placed the following reasons for such a huge accumulated deficit.

- a) The present electricity cost, telephone cost, internet charges, laboratory maintenance charges (including procurement of glasswares and chemicals), annual maintenance of the high-end equipment (like Bruker-X-ray Diffraction, Edinburg-Spectroflurophotometer, Shimadju-FTIR etc), maintenance of the old buildings (6 college buildings and 6 hostel buildings each one older than 50 years) etc. is putting an unbearable heavy load on the college own fund.
- b) Although we collect sufficient amount as fees against the laboratory maintenance, but it is note-worthy that almost 40% students cannot afford the charges of the college and the hostel for which we have to give them scholarship. Every year the total amount of scholarship spent only through the college fund reaches nearly 20 lakhs. SC-ST-OBC scholarships, Merit-cum-means scholarship, DST-INSPIRE fellowship available from the Government also support us. But the amount of these scholarships is sometimes not at par with the requirement of the present-day expenditure of a student; sometimes scholarship comes once in a three year and so on. This compels us either to waive the fees of that student or to give him a scholarship. Hence the revenue earning from the fees becomes much less.
- c) To run the Post Graduate courses with a high standard and to make up the deficiency in the number of teaching staff in all departments, the college has to invite a large number of Guest Faculties. This costs a huge amount and puts a heavy financial load on the college.
- d) Furthermore, following the instruction of the Department of Higher Education, we are submitting 50% of the total Tuition Fees collected from the students.

Resolved that the Principal be authorized to approach the Government for getting sanctioned the entire amount of the Accumulated Deficit amounting Rs 33,55,053.04 (Rupees thirty three lakhs fifty five thousand fifty three and paise zero four only)
