# 4. Semester results ( Semesters 2, 4, 6) and performance of the students in other examinations

#### 7. Admission 2016

The Principal reported that the entire admission procedure for this session has been completed. For 13 UG Honours courses total number of applicants was 6681 amongst whom 170 students were selected through entrance test and viva voce. For 5 PG courses total number of applicants was 235 of whom 62 were admitted through written test and/or viva voce. The second batch of M.Phil. students got admitted into three M.Phil. courses – Bengali, Sanskrit and Philosophy. Total number is 12. Classes for the UG 1<sup>st</sup> year students started on 4 July 2016 and for PG 1<sup>st</sup> year students on 11 July 2016. M.Phil. classes started on 15 September 2016.
