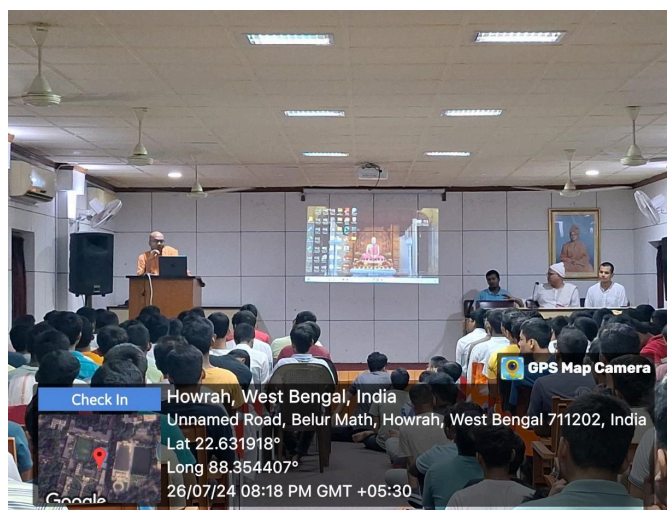

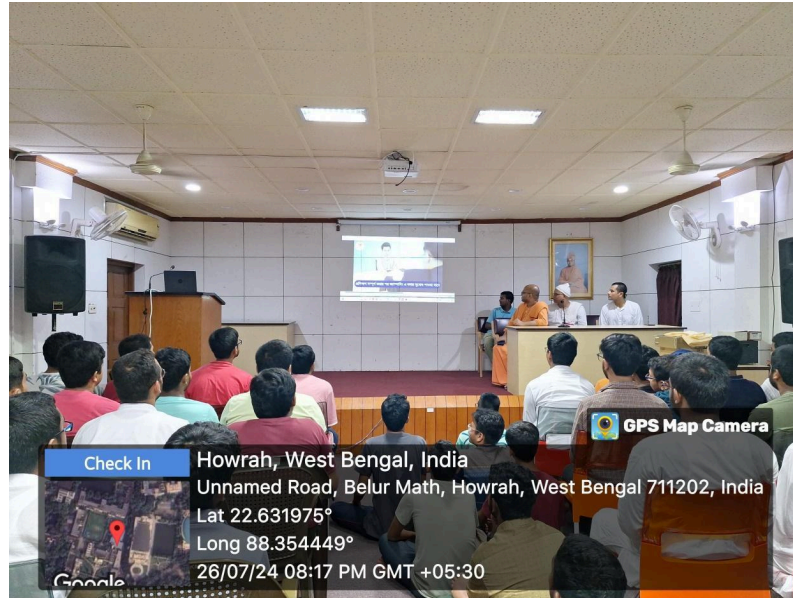
## ❖ **NSS Induction Program:**

### ❖ **University level certificate course on Social Service—Blood Donor Motivation:**

A university level certificate course on Social Service—Blood Donor Motivation was offered to students in collaboration with the Techno Global Hospital Blood Center. This one-day course aims to build up an army of trained honorary blood donor motivators in the community who in turn will be capable of motivating, recruiting and retaining voluntary blood donors and imparting scientific education on blood and blood donation to common people as well as to school students – the donors of tomorrow. She explained the goals of dental checkup and conducted a free dental check-up in Virtual Pharmacy of our college. At the dental check-up the dentist examined the gums and teeth. If there are any cavities that are being formed the dentist were given advice for cavity removal. Later, checks for tartar or plaque that is formed on the teeth and gives advice for removal. Doctors advised them to brush twice a day; visit the dentist twice a year.

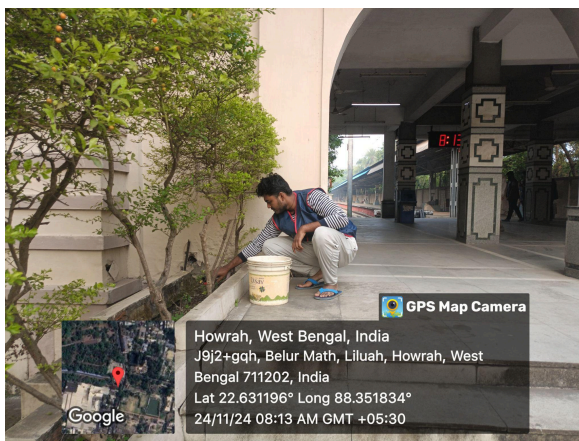
## ❖ Cleaning Programme:-

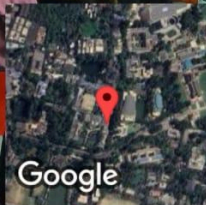
### ❖ **Motivational Speech :**

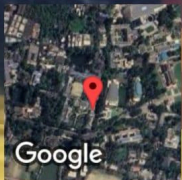
Amid such social scenarios, we have come up with a programme explicitly designed to promote character values and behaviours in the students. This new project have the following objectives -
