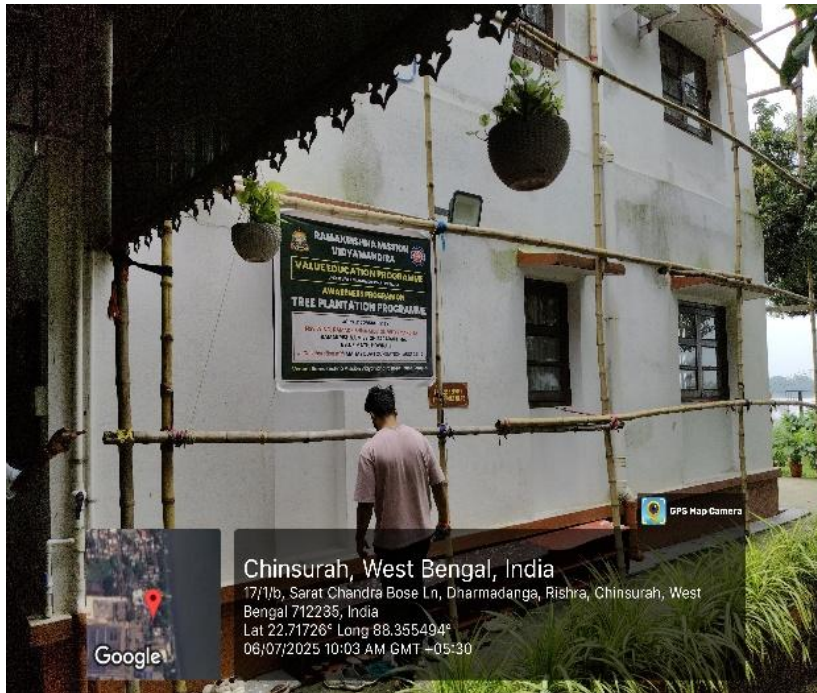

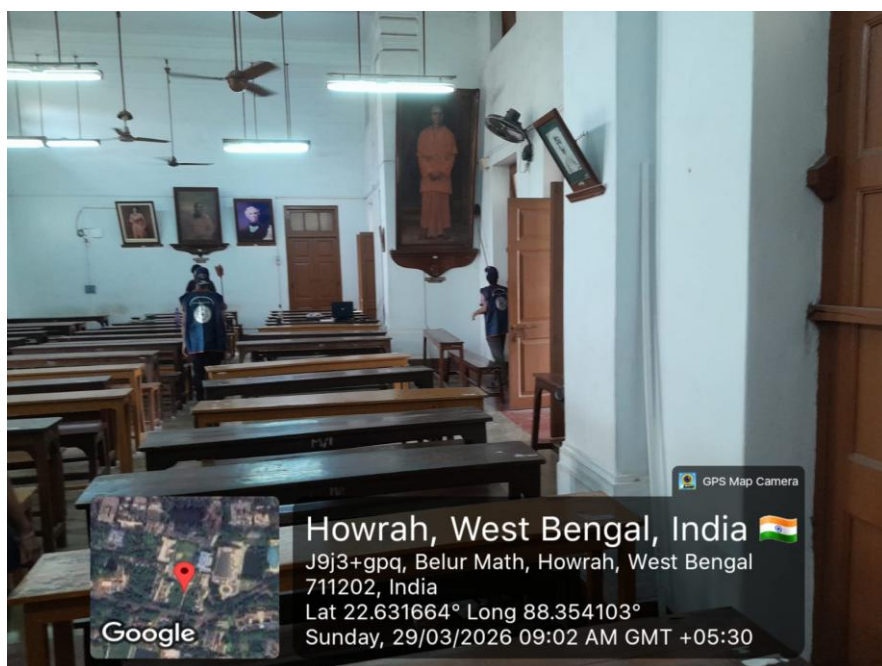
Cleaning Programme
