- An Internal examiner will evaluate the project-article. Principal and the Departmental Committee will decide the name of the examiner for a particular project article.

MPSANP7 Credit 8 Full Marks 100 Book Review

Course Outcome : This course of Book Review will make the research scholar learn the skill to critically appreciate the literary texts and also finding out the research problems or issues that will help him to walk along the innovative avenues of his work.

- Credit : 8
- Students will submit an essay reviewing a book related to the theme on which the concerned student will write his M.Phil. thesis or of his choice (related to the subject) in typed format (minimum word limit 2000)
- An Internal examiner will evaluate the project-article. Principal and the Departmental Committee will decide the name of the examiner for a particular project article (Marks 50).
- There will be a viva voce on this paper. An external examiner will be invited for this viva voce (marks 50).

Semester 3 & 4 <u>MPSANP8</u> <u>Credit 8</u> <u>M.Phil. Dissertation and Evaluation of dissertation (including viva voce on dissertation)</u>

Course Outcome : The monograph writing under the guidance of an expert enhances the capability of researcher and adds to the knowledge domain of the broad arena of the concerned subject.

- Credit : 8 ; Marks : 400
- Student should research on an original topic.
- Thesis should be of minimum 20000 words.
- After the first three months of the 2nd semester, the Departmental Committee in consultation with the Principal will convene a meeting of an Interview Board where all the faculty members and the Principal/Vice Principal will remain present. This board will decide the topic of M.Phil. thesis and the name of the concerned Supervisor.
- By 30th April of the 4th semester students must submit the M.Phil. thesis at the SVRC after signing it from the Supervisor and the Principal with a submission fees of Rs 2000.00. If a student fails to submit his thesis by the above-mentioned date, he has to pay the late fine as par the notification, in case of late submission of the thesis.
- After the evaluation of the thesis, the student will have to appear in a viva voce. Apart from the supervisor, one external expert, Principal or Vice Principal or a representative of the Principal (fulltime teacher of the college) will remain in the viva voce.
- The evaluation of the thesis will be done out of 300 Marks and the viva voce will be of 100 Marks.
